

## Gun License Applications

Dear patient,

This notice is to advise prospective applicants for gun licenses that the Cranleigh Medical Practice does not engage in administration of gun licensing, other than for the provision of Subject Access Requests (SAR). This is in keeping with Home Office guidance that practices will share with a GMC Registered Medical Referee a copy of the patient's medical record upon request. This means that if you are seeking medical endorsement for gun licensing you need to contact a private doctor to begin the application process. The doctor will then, with your consent, contact the medical practice directly to seek a copy of the medical record via the SAR process. You may wish to approach the British Association for Shooting and Conservation regarding their Medical Panel should you be seeking a doctor to assist with your application <https://basc.org.uk/basc-medical-panels/>
